Terminology Guidance

In order to maintain accuracy, consistency, and sensitivity in our communications related to the project, we provide the following guidance on the usage of specific terminology:

Duffy-null:

y-null phenotype:

The "Duffy-null phenotype" refers to the absence of the Duffy antigen on red blood cells due to genetic variation in ACKR1

Duffy non-null:

• Use "Duffy non-null" when referring to individuals with the Duffy positive or Duffy heterozygous (Duffy a positive or Duffy b positive) which collectively are phenotypes that are not associated with lower ANC.

Duffy status:

• Use "Duffy status" when discussing the genetic status related to the presence or

When discussing frequency of the Duffy-null phenotype, avoid using race alone. Rather, describe evolutionary pressures that resulted in the Duffy-null phenotype in malarial endemic regions in Sub-Saharan African and the Arabic Peninsula which resulted in those of certain genetic ancestries to be more likely to have the genetic mutation in ACKR1 resulting in the Duffy-null
